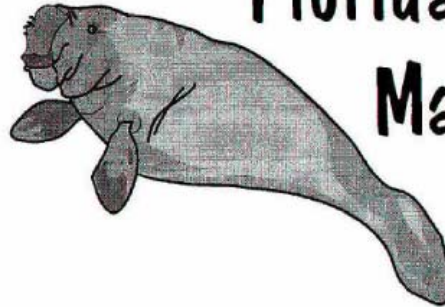

FLORIDA MANATEE FESTIVAL ROTARY CRAFT SHOW

General Information

- The show will be held in historic Old Downtown Crystal River just off Highway 19. Reservations may be made by mail. Please return the application and release form with fees by January 5th, 2007.
- Please sign in on the afternoon of January 12th between 4:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.
There will be directions to the registration desk sent to exhibitors with confirmations. Each exhibitor is expected to have his/her display ready by 8:45 a.m. on Saturday.
- Space allows some exhibitors to park behind some booths. Each 12x12 space will be assigned a number and the numbers will be issued to exhibitors at check-in. A limited number of spaces with parking will be assigned on a first come, first served basis. This will be determined by the order applications are received.
- Booth set up will be on Friday, January 12th from 4 to 7 p.m. Overnight security will be provided Friday and Saturday nights. Overnight parking is allowed in designated areas adjacent to the show grounds. No onsite parking is permitted.
- Lodging is available at several area motels and campgrounds. For more info, please contact the Citrus County Chamber of Commerce at 352-795-3149 or www.citruscountychamber.com
- Creative Crafts and demonstrations are encouraged and welcome. Food and beverages will be available throughout the weekend. Entertainment and other activities will attract a broad audience to the festival. Apply early to ensure your space!
- We cannot control the weather. The show will be held rain or shine. No refunds will be made.
- A \$2.00 donation will be solicited at the gate from the public.

RULES

- All crafts must be original work of the exhibitors. No commercial products are to be displayed.
- Exhibit spaces are approximately 12' x 12'. No sharing of spaces is permitted. Gas powered generators are allowed; please let us know on your application if you plan to use one.
- An application is a commitment for the entire show. No refunds will be given unless you notify us 30 days before the show. Each exhibitor is responsible for collecting Florida sales tax and remitting it to the Department of Revenue.
- All displays will be reviewed by a Viewing Committee prior to the opening of the show. The Committee shall have the absolute right to require removal of any item(s) which violate the Festival Rules. Violations may affect an exhibitor's eligibility for future shows.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

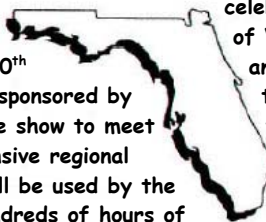
Application fees: An application and release form must be accompanied by a check for \$100.00. The fee will be \$125.00 for applications received after January 5th, 2007. Space is limited so apply early. Make checks payable to The Rotary Club of Crystal River. Applications will not be considered unless completely filled out and accompanied by the fee.

Photographs: All exhibitors are to submit at least 2 current photos of the proposed display and 2 close ups of items to be on display. Photos submitted become the property of the Rotary Club of Crystal River.

Deadline: The absolute final deadline for entries is January 5th, 2007. Applications after the deadline will require an entry fee of \$125.00 and will be considered on a space available basis. Additional applications are available online at www.citruscountyrotary.com.

Security: Overnight security will be provided by the Rotary Club on Friday and Saturday nights only. All exhibitors should plan on vacating the show grounds after the show concludes Sunday evening.
