observed to recognize the accomplishments of students and educators and highlight the collaboration among local leaders, businesses and industry partners that contribute to the success of

CTE programs across Florida.

As of February 7th, Florida has nearly 800,000 K-12 CTE students – the highest postsecondary CTE students, and over

17,000 registered apprentices.
