## **NEXT WEEKEND offers 'Berry Bustin' Fun in Floral City!**

ext weekend, the picturesque Floral Park, Floral City, transforms into a strawberry wonderland for the 37th annual Floral City Strawberry Festival. This beloved event, presented by Jenkins Automotive and produced by the Citrus County Chamber of Commerce, promises a weekend packed with delicious strawberries, mesmerizing live entertainment, and activities that the whole family can enjoy.

Festival-goers are in for a treat with fresh strawberries picked from the local Ferris Groves, the centerpiece of the festival. Imagine indulging in mouth-watering strawberry shortcakes or taking home flats and half-flats of fresh berries to enjoy later. And if you're looking for inspiration on what to do with all those strawberries, the Berry Bakery on the festival's website is your go-to resource.

The festival kicks off on Saturday morning with a patriotic Posting of the Colors, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and the National Anthem. The weekend is jam-packed with live music, featuring a variety of genres to cater to



every taste. Highlights include the bluegrass tunes of ReKindled Bits of Grass and the rock vibes of X-Hale, with special appearances by Sada Davidson and Julia Davis. Sunday continues the musical extravaganza with performances from George Morris & The Lariat Band, among others.

In addition to the musical lineup, the festival offers a chance to explore the roots of the community with tours of the historic Duval-Metz House. Here, visitors can enjoy homemade strawberry ice cream and lemonade in the oldest documented home still standing in Citrus County.

The festival stays true to its American roots with traditional pie-eating contests and princess pageants. Watch as contestants vie for the title of Strawberry Princess or join in the fun of the strawberry pie-eating contest for a chance to win a year's worth of bragging rights.

Adding to the excitement, the Soccer Collies return to dazzle attendees with their ball-handling skills, and the festival welcomes the new Wildlife Walkabout and Activity Center. This interactive experience offers a close-up look at exotic animals, including a sloth, a kangaroo, marmoset monkeys, and more, all in the name of

wildlife conservation.

With over 250 art and craft vendors, a beer garden, and a plethora of food options, the festival is a perfect weekend getaway. The kids' area ensures that the youngest visitors will have just as much fun as the adults.

Mark your calendars for March 2nd & 3rd, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturday and 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Sunday. Admission is just \$5 for adults, with children 12 and under entering for free. Free parking and shuttle services are available from the Citrus County Auditorium on Saturday and the Citrus County Speedway on Sunday.
