This formidable coalition traveled to the Florida Capitol with a unified mission: to champion the issues that are vitally important to our community.

Throughout the week, attendees engaged with top officials with key agencies-including the Florida Ports Council, Florida Housing Finance

tion, Florida Department of Children and Family Services, and Florida Department of Agriculture, addressing topics like workforce development, mental health, insurance reform, springs restoration, local housing, and transportation. The Thursday session also featured presentations by the Florida Department of Education, Florida Department of Environmental Protection, Florida Chamber of Commerce, and Florida Department of Transportation, underlining the

collaboration in driving local progress.

One of the most memorable moments was a special invitation from Senate President Ben Albritton for a rare behind-the-scenes experience. The entire delegation had the chance to sit on the Senate Chamber Floor, debate a mock bill, and then upon the call of President Albritton, vote on it-offering a firsthand perspective on the legislative process alongside the opportunity to speak directly with the Senate President.
