ast month, a delegation from the Citrus County Chamber of Commerce, joined by several local government and business leaders, spent two days at the Florida Chamber's Leadership Conference on Safety, Health & Sustainability in Orlando and another full day at the Florida Chamber Foundation's Prosperity & Economic Opportunity Solution Summit in Daytona Beach. Our goal was simple: listen, learn and bring home practical strategies that will help Citrus County thrive.

At the Leadership Conference on Safety, Health & Sustainability, held
