Learners to Earners Summit

S taff from the Citrus County Chamber of Commerce joined more than 400 business, education, and workforce leaders at the Florida Chamber Foundation's Learners to Earners Workforce Solution Summit on June 24. This one-day forum examined how Florida can fortify its talent pipeline "from cradle to career," and the Chamber delegation returned energized with ideas to implement locally.

A central takeaway was the decisive impact of early-childhood investment. Speakers demonstrated how data-driven programs are improving kindergarten readiness and third-grade literacy. Complementing the research, several panels showcased employer strategies, such as flexible scheduling and on-site child care, that help working parents while cultivating tomorrow's workforce. The summit also underscored the value of hands-on learning. Sessions featuring TECO and Miller Electric highlighted paid internships and apprenticeships that allow participants to earn credentials while gaining real-world experience, a clear win for both learners and employers. In a related discussion on second-chance hiring, experts outlined policies that enable returning citizens to reenter the labor market and add immediate value to Florida's economy.

Armed with fresh data, proven practices, and new partnerships, the Chamber team is now working to translate these statewide insights into Citrus County initiatives, ensuring every learner in our community has a clear pathway to become a skilled, in-demand earner.
